MyDFI - MEMBER PORTAL

Many resources are available to members when you sign in to *My*DFI. Go to **www.dfi.org** and sign in with your email and password. If you don't have a password, a temporary one will be provided, which you can change once you are logged in.

Check Your Membership Status: When you sign in, your *My*DFI screen will show your membership status.

Pay Dues: Pay your dues online by credit card or print an invoice for payment by check or wire transfer.

Update Contact Info: Check that your contact information is correct in our database — click on "Contact Info" on the left-hand side and make any necessary changes. You can opt to receive your copy of *Deep Foundations* magazine at a designated address. You can also indicate if you would like to opt out of receiving print versions of the magazine.

Change Password: Change your password to *My*DFI at any time.

Download Certificates: Download your membership certificate and certificates for education credits (PDHs) received for event attendance.

MyPublications: Access all publications you have downloaded or purchased from the DFI publications store.

Access Online Proceedings: Access online programs, presentations and proceedings from DFI seminars and conferences that you have registered for and attended, or online proceedings that you have purchased.

Log in to OneMine: Automatically log in to OneMine to access more than 140,000 free publications. This single login means you don't have to register or log in again on the OneMine site.

View *DFI Journal* **Papers:** Access the *Journal* website where you can login and access current and past issues.

View Members Roster: Access an up-to-date member roster of DFI individual members and corporate representatives and send them a message. The roster is searchable by first or last name, company name, position/job title.

Access Student Resumes: Corporate Members can access resumes that have been provided by student members and students who have received or applied for DFI Educational Trust At-Large scholarships. Resumes can be sorted and filtered based on various criteria.
